Why the Fixer Mixer? The "P" Words

- Potential!
 Pro-active vs reactive effort
 Focused on Positive ideas, not the negative
- PURPOSE: A social/work session, 75% ideas, 25% networking
- GOALS:
 - Generate pro-active & positive ideas for Vallejo
 - Bring together active citizens to create synergy

What & When

- 4-hour workshop & potluck, March 9
- More than 120 attendees, ~500 volunteer hours
- 13 tables for small group brainstorming, volunteer facilitators
- 3 rotations so everyone had chance to participate at different tables
- Facilitation software by Group Vision, simultaneous capture of ideas, immediate reports

Education

- Affects kids, safety & econ devt
- After-hours community centers at schools
- Intro to PS jobs; trade school classes
- Closed campuses. DARE prgm
- Council & VCUSD "joined at the hip"

Youth, Recreation, Civic Engagement

Youth & recreation

 Bookmobiles, skate park, rec center in Central Vjo, outdoor hoops, events like 5k races & chili cook-offs; youth, citizens & police softball and basketball

Civic engagement

 Pro-active outreach to neighborhoods, different ethnic groups. Cultivate participation & leadership.
 Encourage students to attend city meetings so that they have a voice.

Safety & Law Enforcement

- Adopt-a-cop, neighborhood liaison program
- Community policing w/ neighborhoods involved;
- Quarterly Town Hall w/Chief of Police
- Restore or introduce prgms like Beat Health, Combat Auto Theft, Shot Spotter, Click Fix for crime reports
- Increase traffic fines & enforcement
- Sting operation: metal thieves & buyers

Circulation, Transportation Help Commuters & Tourists

- Commuter service up to 12am, bus to EC accept small bills, give change; wine train Vallejo-Napa; 440 charger; better link to BART
- Better lighting, speed bumps, "parklets"
- Pothole-counting contest! Winner gets alignment & 4 tires

Housing

- Rental property registration
- Crime-Free Multi-Unit for all complexes
- De-concentrate subsidized housing across all census tracts: 59% downtown
- More market rate housing, esp downtown
- Encourage rehab & renovate vs new construction
- More support for 1st time buyers, underwater mortgages, owners at risk of foreclosure
- Squatter control (in progress!)

Heritage & Preservation

- Leverage Vjo history in all public materials
- Create historic walking tours
- Encourage historic designation areas
- Develop list of historic bldgs for preservation
- Historic restoration training for home-owners
 & unemployed
- Transition renters to home ownership w/ 5 yr prgm

Land Use & Open Space

- Give timely notices & info on zoning changes
- Expand # of Historic Dists & use of Historical Bldg Code
- Community Gardens in all areas (PB!)
- Bury power lines; bike path from Vjo to other cities; plant trees; protect wetlands; complete River Park, create dog park
- Feature open space & recreation on COV website
- Update zoning to protect wetlands along MI, White Slough, Napa River

Environment, Noise, Climate, Air Quality

- Recycle bins in all public spaces
- More aggressive tree planting to mitigate pollution
- Zero waste policy
- Encourage solar (Berkeley, PA, Menlo Pk)
- Better noise abatement ordinances & enforcement, esp "donuts", amplified music
- Designated bike paths

Economic Development

- Market Vallejo w/better image
- Support nature & history tourism
- Give small biz tax breaks & grants (see PB!)
- Streamline biz licenses (underway!)
- Better zoning to distribute biz
- More festivals & amateur races
- Market homes to young profs
- Help MI biz w/costs, get Lennar cooperation
- Implement downtown plan from Aug 2012
- Allow more Mom & Pop quick stores (no alcohol), in food deserts

Specific Target Zones:

- Downtown reduce 60% vacancies; leverage 18 fiber optic lines; attract satellite campus, e.g. Acad of Art; water taxi to MI; flea mkt; walking tour; volunteer policing
- Waterfront expand weekend ferry; daily trash pick-up; soccer/volleyball fields; vaporetti to Napa; better mktg
- Mare Island history tourism, promote
 Preserve; outreach to Vjoans; Welcome Ctr;
 B&B; wine tasting rooms; solar farm;
 transport to & on island (Thomas the Train)

Take-Away Lessons: Harness our Passion!

- Vallejoans are mobilized & ready to work
 - Fixer Mixer; 300 NW groups; Participatory
 Budgeting, hundreds of volunteers; PS Ad Hoc
 Committee; Common Ground w/1200 attendees;
 Lamplighter, MI Preserve, Filipino community,
 Chamber, Faith community, youth.
 - Cheaper than consultants! Price for 500 hours --\$20-50/hr, \$10-25k?
- Engage grassroots energy to rebuild our city
- P-words: pro-active, positive, pragmatic, passionate, potential!
